

Winter-Fest Planned February 28 - March 2



EIGHT TONS OF CHAMPIONS — Eight tons of champion registered Clydesdale horses will be coming back to Garrett County February 28 and March 1 and 2 for this year's Winter-Fest activities. The horses will arrive in three 40 by 8 feet vans, two for the ten horses which are brought, and one for the huge, 3½ ton brass-trimmed wagon and the \$30,000 worth of brass and leather harness. Six men care for the horses when they travel, a driver, assistant driver and four chauffeur-grooms who take care of the horses and harness. They are accompanied by "Bud," the Dalmation mascot who rides on the wagon.
