

# Deep Creek Lake Lions Club Park and Meshach Browning Trail System Map

The Deep Creek Lake Lions Club manages the county-owned community park on Bumble Bee Rd. Facilities include a fenced dog run area, ballfield, disc golf course, picnic pavilion, art installation and restrooms. Further projects in the southern area of the park are in development. Adjacent to the park, the club has developed the Meshach Browning Trail System, a non-motorized trail network providing a low to mid-level intensity experience with a mix of wide and single-track widths. An interpretive exhibit at the trailhead provides information on the life and times of Meshach Browning, an early settler of Garrett County.

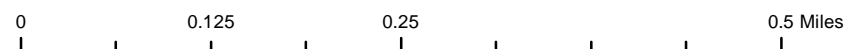
*Meshach Browning Trail System Area*

**Trail Notes:**  
 Mary's Path, Glade View and Gunner's Run are wide, mostly in open area and cover little elevation change.  
 The Bear Scat trail has some single track sections, traverses wooded areas, with more elevation change and two very small stream crossings.  
 Panther Prowl trail has large sections of single track, one larger stream crossing and the most elevation change of the system.  
 The southern part of Creek Track trail cuts through a laurel thicket, while the northern section follows Meshach Run and provides a less steep climb than Panther Prowl.  
 The White Trails provide shortcuts for Bear Scat, Creek Track and Panther Prowl.  
 Traversing the full trail perimeter is about 3.6 miles total.
